*The Berenstain Bears Don't Pollute Anymore* written by Stan and Jan Berenstain

*The Great Trash Bash* written and illustrated by Loreen Leedy

*Our Earth: A Question and Answer Book* written by John Malam

*The Wartville Wizzard* written by Don Madden
